Centenary 2017/18 Snippet: Our first parish priest, Fr Michael Paul Kelly OFM, died in Ireland on 7 November 1965. Born in Ireland in 1882, he entered the Franciscans in 1901 and was ordained a priest in 1908. He came to Sydney in 1909 and was pastor of Waverley (*which then included Clovelly*) from 1915 to 1917, before taking charge of Clovelly in 1917. His obituary in the Catholic Weekly recorded that when he first moved to Clovelly he cooked his own breakfast and tea, and walked up the hill to the Franciscan Friary at Waverley for the midday meal. Another parish remembrance is of him pedalling an old army bicycle over the grassy slopes on parish visitations. He was Clovelly's parish priest until November 1930, when the Archbishop removed Clovelly from Franciscan care.
