Plenary Council 2020: Those who must be called to the Council include all archbishops & bishops, vicars-general, episcopal vicars, some superiors & congregational leaders of religious orders, & some seminary rectors (a total of 160-175 people, including about 10 women). In addition, those who can be called include clergy, lay people & retired bishops; however, this second group must number less than half the first group. Others can be invited as advisers, consultors or observers. Only the first group has a decision-making vote - their decisions will be forwarded to Rome to ensure they are consistent with the universal teachings of the Catholic Church, & then the legislation becomes binding for the Catholic Church in Australia.
