Centenary Snippet: We have had a bad flu season this year. But in 1919 the 'Spanish Flu' epidemic was raging around the world, and caused more than 12,000 deaths in Australia. Our parish school had to close for a period (*as did other places where people gathered*). The Sisters tacked two red flannel oval badges of the Sacred Heart over the school doors and prayed for protection - their prayers were answered as no parishioner died from the complaint. Parishioners gave money to the Sisters to help support them while the school was closed.
