CENTENARY 2017/18 SNIPPET: St Anthony's School opened on **28 January 1918** with **45 pupils & 2 teachers**, Sr Leonorus & Sr Louis Gonzaga. These **Sisters of St Joseph** came from Bondi every day for a year, until a cottage was rented for them in Clovelly. The school included secondary classes to Intermediate level, plus a Commercial class, up to 1962. Its peak enrolment was **480** around **1936** – somehow they all fitted into a building about half the size of the current school!
