RCIA PROGRAM Enquiring to become a Catholic? Contact the parish office.

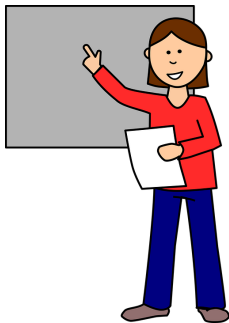
